ANNUAL MEMBERS MEETING!

The Annual Members Meeting was held March 23 at HC Media. President Ann Jones introduced members of the board and committees and praised their hard work and

dedication. She gave an overview of all that was accomplished during the past year and what's on the calendar for 2019-2020. The main item on the agenda was the proposal to bring the GHAA constitution and by-laws in line with the procedures for carrying out the organization's mission. The proposed revision, with one amendment (to replace the word 'family' with 'household' in Article III, Section 2, describing the types of membership) was passed unanimously. The new document can be found on the website. Members were encouraged to sign up for volunteer opportunities: exhibits, hospitality, scholarship, judges for awards, modeling for portraiture at the Saturday Workshops.
