We are going ahead VIRTUALLY with the Art Festival September 12! Our secretary Melissa will be hosting a LIVE exhibit/sale on our Facebook page that day, 10 AM til noon. Registrants receive an email invitation to participate. More info will be ready for the September newsletter. Because of the uncertainty about a permit from the city and restrooms in the church, and the stringent guidelines from the state, we regretfully cancel the outdoor version of the event.

Susan Kneeland will be doing two demos again this month, available at 10 AM on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays, via the link on our Facebook page. On August 11 she will show how to draw an animal using charcoal. On August 25 she will demo a drawing using white on a black background. Her July demos (landscape in three primaries and white, and a monochromatic portrait) are still available for viewing.

Our members exhibit for September - October at the Haverhill Public Library is still on, though the dates may change - the gallery is on the 2nd level which is not yet open. The registration form is here and we are again waiving the hanging fees. The deadline to enter is August 26; delivery is September 1, and pick-up is October 31 - all dates subject to change. Our 2020 members' summer exhibit is at the Centennial Gallery in the Musculoskeletal Center in Peabody through **Saturday August 7**. Because the Gallery is very large and spacious, members can visit the show comfortably, but the building requires masks and distancing.
