The final day was the exhibit and reception - a successful and fun event. It's a great way to spend some time working at your art, and we look forward to our fourth year in 2019.

We Are Haverhill: Changing Faces of Haverhill's Neighborhoods is an exhibit of photographs at HC Media Studio 101, Harbor Place, 2 Merrimack Street, Haverhill. The exhibit continues until February 16 and is open to the public: Tuesdays 10am-12pm, Thursdays, 5-8pm, and Saturdays 9am-12pm.

The gallery space is one the GHAA is considering for exhibits, so check out the venue at the same time with that in mind. Our next three demos will be held there, as well as the Annual Meeting.

We have a field trip arranged in February to the commercial photography studio of **ImageTec** in Methuen. Interested members will meet there on Saturday, February 17 at 11 AM. • Innovation Hub at Harbor Place (2 Merrimack Street, Haverhill, 3rd floor) is collaborating with the GHAA to feature members in an Art Niche on the third floor. The space lends itself to featuring a single artist for a two-month period. Two adjacent walls (5 ft and 8 ft) can accommodate 2 very large paintings or 10 very small paintings, or a mix of in-between sizes. - Tracy Meola, member artist and owner of Art on Main Gallery is offering *The Art On Main A to Z 26 Week Art Challenge*.
