- Innovation Hub of UMASS Lowell at Harbor Place (2 Merrimack Street, Haverhill, 3rd floor) is partnering with the GHAA to showcase members in an Art Niche, a space that lends itself to featuring a single artist for a two-month period. Two adjacent walls (5 ft and 8 ft) can accommodate 2 very large paintings or 10 very small paintings, or a mix of in-between sizes. There is a surface for promotional materials and perhaps a small sculpture. The venue hours are Monday Friday, 8:30 5:00 (www.uml.edu/ihub). There is no charge to participate; the usual 65/20/15 % (artist/GHAA/venue) will apply to any sales. If you are interested in participating, respond to info@ghaa.art. Michael Gurino is the Featured Artist for November-December.
- Sarah's Place is a non-profit adult day health center for the elderly in Haverhill, striving to keep their days diverse and busy. They offer craft and painting classes but would like to have demonstrations of visual arts by local artists just for them to observe. They are a non-profit but could provide a small stipend.
