ARTISTIC OPPORTUNITIES

Copley Master Mark Hayden and local artist Mimi Johnson, GHAA Saturday Workshop artists, are teaching four-day Summer Workshops. Two sessions are available July 24-27 and July 31-August 3. The morning sessions are for intensive portrait study (9:30-11:30) at Hayden Studios. Using oil or pastel (bring your own materials), Mark will guide you through the process of creating a successful portrait. The same model will be used during the four-day session. During a one-hour lunch (bring your own), discussions about artists and art, critiques and demonstrations will be encouraged.

The afternoon sessions are for exploring projects for creativity building

(12:30-2:30) at Mimi's studio. Mimi will focus on color theory and compositional elements using a variety of materials (provided) including fused glass, paper making, altered books and printmaking concepts.
