The **GHAA Annual Meeting** will be held at 1 PM on Saturday, March 24, at HC Media TV Studio, 2 Merrimack Street, Haverhill. Please try to attend - there will be door prizes! Parking is available in the parking garage diagonally across the street (paid) or in the Market Basket plaza diagonally across the square (free).

**GHAA elections** will be held March 24 at the Annual Meeting. The Officers and Standing Committee Chairs are listed on the website.
