deadline to apply for the Robert Gablosky Memorial Scholarship has been extended to May 15. The guidelines are on the GHAA website, and the application is online via the link there.

CDC advisories have been extended, so the GHAA has canceled events through May, including the Annual Open Exhibit at Buttonwoods. The Board decided that receiving and hanging the art the last weekend in May would be risky at best, and hosting a reception would be out of the question. We regret having to cancel one of our most popular events of the year, but concern for the safety of all is of utmost importance.

We are setting our sights now on the members' exhibit at the Centennial Gallery in Peabody during July and August - look for news about that in the June newsletter.
