GHAA NEWS

The GHAA Art Festival on Bradford Common on September 9 was a great success, in spite of being cut a bit short by a sudden downpour half an hour before closing time. We had 40% more artists participating than last year. There was a steady stream of visitors all day, and there were many sales. Jake Baynes played his jazz/blues guitar in the morning, and John Hyde serenaded with his accordian in the afternoon. This event always brings us new members and supporters, and stirs interest in the Saturday Workshops (which the Art Festival subsidizes). Thanks to all who made it a wonderful day - including those scrambling to the aid of neighboring artists to save their goods from the rain!

REINVENT COGSWELL is hosting an open house on Saturday, October 28, 9-5, to showcase the project of making the beautiful old brick school into an art center. The public will get a glimpse of the future as they see the GHAA Workshop in progress (9-12) in one area, art activities for children in another, and an art display in the gallery space. We are very excited to be a part of this - join us for the workshop and /or visit the open house to find out just why! Cogswell is on South Main Street two blocks up the street from the Bradford Common.

Paul Graveline, editor of <u>NSArtEvents.com</u>, interviewed several members of the GHAA for a feature in the current online issue.
