And **Tracy Meola's** painting glass, **Emily Passman's** working from photos, **Doris Rice'** watercolor, **Lisa Regopoulos'** pastel, **Nella Lush's** encaustic, **Mary Taggart's** gouache, **Ann Jones'** *Tracking Your Art* and **Joan Turner's** many teaching videos can be viewed. We've presented these to you free while waiting for the Saturday Workshops to resume.

Graciela Trilla of Haverhill curated an exhibit at Buttonwoods of her family's collection of art by Puerto Rican artists from the 1950s. It's a bilingual exhibit "La Generación de los Cincuentas" / "The Generation of the 50s" featuring 26 pieces of art including drawings, lithographs, wood carvings, serigraphs, traditional Puerto Rican mundillo textiles, and 15 posters. It includes a Mundillo wheel – a device for making traditional bobbin lace - from the Museo de Mundillo de Puerto Rico. The show also displays ceramics by Puerto Rican artist Atlas Moon Rodriguez Decker. The exhibit is at Buttonwoods through October 30.

There's a big 'art' yard sale - the contents of a studio - on October 2 (10-3) at 410 Chestnut Street in Wilmington.
