GHAA NEWS

The **GHAA Art Festival** on Bradford Common will be September 9 (10-4). Registration forms are available online and **HERE**. Ads have appeared in *Artscope* and *Art New England* and

at http://www.artshow.com. It's not too late to participate! If not showing and selling your work that day, do stop by and support your fellow artists. There will be some morning and afternoon music to keep us entertained.

Paul Graveline, editor of <u>NSArtEvents.com</u>, interviewed several members of the GHAA for a feature in the current online issue. Jeff Grassie, Ann Jones, Susan Kneeland, Daniel Shaw, and Debbie Shirley spoke about their own art as well as about the GHAA. The video can be seen at NSArtEvents.com and on YouTube.

Mary Ellen Brown will be the next demo artist on September 24, 2 - 4 PM at Buttonwoods, creating a still life in pastels. She aims for simple elegance and mood in her paintings, to give a sense of peace and beauty. Inspired by the Old Dutch Masters, she renders subjects in great detail. She teaches as well as exhibits, and is a member of the Pastel Guild of Europe, Pastel Society of America, Pastel Society of New Hampshire, Hollis Art Society, The Whistler House Museum of Art - Lowell Art Association, and the Western Avenue Artist Association, maintaining a studio at Western Avenue in Lowell.

Debra Claffey will do layering encaustic using pigment sticks creating an abstract still life for the October 29 demo. Note that this demo will take place on the *last* Sunday of the month.

Our next members show will be the Holiday Exhibit at the Haverhill Public Library during November and December. Receiving and hanging will take place Tuesday, October 31, 2:30 - 4:30 in the gallery area upstairs in the library. The reception will be Sunday, November 5, 2:30 - 4:30. Pick-up will be at the close of the show, Saturday December 30, 2:30 - 4:30. Register online **HERE** or download the form **HERE**.
